ACCOMMODATION



AT CAER RHUN HALL WE OFFER A CHOICE OF INDIVIDUALLY DESIGNED MASTER SUITES AND 23 BEDROOMS IN THE MAIN HOUSE, RANGING FROM SPACIOUS KINGSIZE DOUBLES TO COSY DOUBLES AND SINGLES ALL WITH GARDEN OR COURTYARD VIEWS. THE VILLA AND COURTYARD WITHIN THE GROUNDS PROVIDE ANOTHER NINE BEDROOMS. ALL TOGETHER WE CAN ACCOMMODATE UP TO 58 OF YOUR GUESTS.

The three Masters are beautifully designed, spacious and include free standing baths overlooking the breathtaking views. The perfect retreat at the end of your special day.

For weddings Sunday to Thursday, a minimum of 15 rooms must be booked.

For Friday weddings, a minimum of 25 rooms must be booked.

For Saturday weddings, 30 rooms must be booked.

Check-in time for accommodation is 3pm and check out is at 11am.

EXTRA GUESTS

Some rooms have sofa beds, ideal for additional guests. We also have a limited number of rollaway beds and cots for little ones. Additional charges for extra guests apply.

- Once you have viewed the house and decided on a date, this date can be held for 14 days with no obligation.
- During this time, we will send you a booking form, payment schedule and our terms and conditions for your perusal. It is important that you read through all the details before signing and returning these to us. If you have any queries, please contact us before completing your booking form.
- To confirm your date, please return your completed booking form and make payment of the booking fee, this will be a non-refundable deposit of £1500. Once received, your wedding date will be confirmed.
- You must book your wedding ceremony through a registrar or your chosen church or chapel directly. It is important to make contact with them within the 14 day period. Contact the Conwy Registration Team on 01492 574000
- We would like to highlight that all booking fees, balances, and monies payable under our terms and conditions are non-refundable. We ask that you take out the appropriate wedding insurance and provide us with written confirmation.
- All payments must be made by BACS quoting your booking reference, unless we direct you otherwise in writing.
- Once payment has been received you will be issued with a payment confirmation.





FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Can we have fireworks or lanterns?

Due to our rural location, surroundings and wildlife we are unable to allow fireworks or lanterns.

What time can wedding guests check-in?

Our check in time is from 3pm. Where possible we will accommodate early check in requests but these are limited and additional charges apply for this.

What time is check-out for guests?

We ask all our guests to vacate their rooms by 11am.

Who sets up the tables on the wedding day?

Our team will set out the tables with table linen, crockery and glassware. Your venue dresser or member of the wedding party will be required to dress the tables to your requirements.

Can we bring our own wine or other beverages?

We do not allow you to bring your own wine or beverages, however should you have anything specific in mind we can source this for you with advance notice.

What time does the entertainment and bar finish?

Your wedding must end by midnight, however guests who are staying overnight at Caer Rhun Hall can continue to purchase drinks at the main bar. We request that music is kept to a reasonable sound level.

What time is last orders?

Last orders are at 11.30pm. Caer Rhun Hall is a cashless venue, so only card payment are accepted. Please ensure all your wedding guests are aware of this.

Is there a taxi service?

Guests should pre-book their own transportation as our rural location can make last minute arrangements difficult. Non-residents must have left Caer Rhun Hall by 12.30am

What time is breakfast served?

Continental Breakfast is served from 7.30am - 10am midweek and 8am - 10.30am on the weekend.

Can we have confetti?

Only real, dried petals can be used at the venue.

Do we offer Disabled facilities?

Caer Rhun Hall offers easy access to the ground floor and we also have a ground floor easy access guestroom. Please note that this room is not located in the main house but is situated in the Courtyard located in the grounds of Caer Rhun Hall.

Can my dog come to the ceremony and stay at Caer Rhun Hall?

Yes, your dog is more than welcome to attend the ceremony, we have a number of rooms which are dog friendly. Please note that we do ask that you sign a disclaimer on check-in and that your dog is not left unattended in the guest rooms.

Do you allow camper vans on site?

We don't allow any guests to stay in any type of vehicle overnight. Please ask for the list of our recommended hotels, bed and breakfast and campsites.





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
